Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TNCC: Indirect costs per student - \$75 to National, \$68 for books = \$144 each, then there is about \$130 per student to pay instructors – not much left over for profit to obtain new equipment, purchase coffee, etc. – How do we continue to have classes and still be financially and have enough instructors? Few students who are eligible to become instructors are interested. Instructors need to teach one lecture and one skill station within 18 mo. to maintain their instructor. • Last TNCC class 19 students passed, the director-candidate to be finalized in May • Need new equipment for both TNCC and ENPC – 4 new adult manikins have been purchased • Need more course directors – current directors would like to cut back/retire • If anyone needs peds equipment for classes for anything, please contact S.
